

FAITH MINISTER VISITS OTHONA ESSEX

Faith Minister Lord Bourne spent the morning (13 May) with Othona Essex to mark the sixth leg of his current national faith tour. The Minister visited a number of community projects around Essex where people have been inspired by their faith to do something above and beyond their day-to-day work.
