All manner of plumbing and electrical works are being carried out to ensure the whole of Othona Bradwell is properly supplied with electricity and hot water, including the under-floor heating system. The planning applications are in hand, with a view to installation of a second wind-generator by the Summer. The Othona Team and Volunteers continue to contribute. The new Education Building is nearing completion, with particular thanks to Trevor Darley and Mick Crowe. The whole Othona site is now out of bounds to all visitors.

Tim, with one or two Volunteers, is at Othona while the works proceed. Debbie and Richard are taking a well-earned break for January. The next European Volunteer Group will be welcomed in the Spring. The Programme is out there, and we ask everyone to keep spreading the word; we are still taking bookings and look forward to seeing you all soon.

The Community - Members, Friends - urged the Committees and Trustees to take a Green view. The new project drastically reduces our carbon footprint, shifts Othona to a long-term future with green fuel and electricity, and opens our doors to a Sustainable future.

The BCC is a small and committed group of people. We have room for one or two more people, and have hopes of including someone with a fresh approach to reconciliation in this troubled world.
