Themes I feel should be up for interpretation so as broad as possible as people can get really creative so;

First workshop theme is Summer - you could focus on so many things especially with the unpredictable weather. Up to you. That's what's fun. What does Summer mean to you?

Second workshop theme is 'Post' - could be fun as people could focus on a variety of things - the postman delivering letters, fence posts in a beautiful summer landscape, the aftermath of the first shared lockdown bbq/drinks with friends...

Photos are taken - everyone is given a full day to go out and take photos on the day's theme and submit their entry before the end of the next day. Review/critique - Everyone talks about the photo they've taken.

It's not about technique, artistic eye or any of the above - because these things are all subjective. It's about everyone taking photos together, being supportive, having some chat and learning along the way and just doing something together.
